Chemistry Teacher (approximately 8 teaching hours per week)

Daily activities

You will teach classes of approximately 15 to 20 international students. The preparation of your lessons can sometimes be done individually and sometimes as part of a team. As part of the teaching team, you will create, invigilate, and grade credit-bearing examinations. Grading student examination papers is a key feature of this role. You will be required to liaise with your colleagues about the content of your lessons, and the College's management team about the students' progress.

You will also have the opportunity to create new teaching materials for yourself. You will also be involved in formal and semi-formal observations of lessons, gaining useful feedback to ensure the quality of your teaching remains as high as possible. You will be in regular contact with your colleagues about the content of the lessons and the students' progress.

Given the international context, you will be expected to cater for cultural differences in the group and occasionally participate in activities inside and outside the lessons to help the students integrate.

You are:

A key requirement of this position is for you to have the ability to work equally well independently and as part of a team. In addition, you will have extensive knowledge of Chemistry and can impart this knowledge to learners at VWO 6 level. You are comfortable speaking in English in front of large audiences, both online and face to face.
